Re: Intervention Sessions

I am writing to encourage you to support us in ensuring that students access intervention that is put on by the school. Lots of intervention to support students to get the best possible grades at A level happens within the classroom, however in some cases we do ask students to attend extra sessions particularly as the examination period approaches. We have Year 12 exams at the beginning of May and the Year 13 public examinations begin on the 12th of May 2025. We ask that students consider reducing their hours at paid jobs and consider carefully the commitments they have outside of school.
