## RE: World Mental Health Day Thursday 10th October 2024

St Bernard's is a school where we take a holistic approach to the education of each and every young person in our community. Part of this involves making students aware of how the choices they make can have a positive impact on their own wellbeing. Mental Health is discussed as part of the PSHE curriculum and the strong focus on the pastoral role of the tutor and Head of Year means that students are confident to discuss when they are feeling like they need extra help. Pastoral provision within the school means that there are various sources of help available to your child if they need it. As a school, we recognise that life is sometimes stressful and that there may be times when students need extra help. - We will be running a self-care workshop during lunchtime on 10<sup>th</sup> October, providing craft activities and friendly chat focused on self-care.
- Finally, after school on October 10th, we will be showing 'Inside Out' (certificate U) as part of our collaboration with the Film Education charity 'Into Film.' Entry is just £1 to students, with places allocated on a first come first served basis with numbers capped at 100. *Tickets are available on ParentPay from*
- 9am on Monday 30th September and all donations will again, go to 'Young Minds'. If your child wishes to attend, you MUST pay and give permission via ParentPay before Friday 4<sup>th</sup> October. We expect the film to finish at 5:10 pm and students are responsible for making their own way home.
