Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to let you know that **Friday 30th January** will be a non-school uniform day. To take part, we ask that each student brings £1 in cash, which will be collected at the school gate as they arrive in the morning.

All proceeds will go towards fundraising for our Camps International expedition to Peru in Summer 2027, where students will take on a challenging programme of community and environmental work. The trip will push them outside their comfort zone as they contribute to meaningful projects, develop resilience, and experience life in a very different part of the world.

Although students do not need to wear school uniform on the day, the school's usual expectations regarding make-up and jewellery will still apply. Clothing must be appropriate for a school setting: T-shirts should be of an appropriate length and fit, offering adequate coverage; skirts must be no shorter than the standard school-approved length; and shorts must be no shorter than mid-thigh. Students should also ensure they are dressed suitably for the weather. Please note that Crocs, sliders, or similar footwear are not permitted to be worn at school.

We hope this will be a fun day for the school community, while supporting a fantastic opportunity for our students.
