



Dear Parents/ Carers

Thank you for your support in raising funds and purchasing a wristband for your child to participate in all the fun events this week for RAG week. Wristbands will be given out on Monday in tutor time so if you are yet to purchase one for your child, this can be done over the weekend.

Friday (10th July) will be a non uniform day to finish off our celebrations and raise as much money for RAG week as possible! Students who wish to dress in non-uniform should bring £1, which is payable on the gate to Mrs Bailey. Those who do not wish to take part can wear school uniform/ PE kit as normal.

Please ensure that clothing follows these guidelines:

- Shorts and skirts should be around mid-thigh length. Denim shorts are allowed and should be at least mid-thigh.
- Tops must provide appropriate coverage. T-shirts are acceptable; however, strappy tops (spaghetti straps), crop tops, short T- shirts or low-cut tops should not be worn.
- Clothing must not display offensive, inappropriate, or unsuitable slogans, images, or language.
- Footwear must be safe and suitable for school – flip-flops, Crocs, or similar open footwear are not permitted.

Please note that all other school rules remain in place, including those relating to make-up, jewellery and piercings, which should not be worn.

Students who arrive in clothing that does not meet these expectations may be asked to change into spare school uniform where available or placed in isolation if the uniform infringement cannot be corrected.
