## RE: Year 10 Core Games Programme

Dear Parents and Guardians,

The intention of the core PE curriculum is to maintain a healthy lifestyle by offering broad and engaging opportunities for students to stay physically active. Therefore, from January, term 2 the PE department will be offering the opportunity to participate in some new off-site activities during your daughter's fortnightly core games lesson. These have been heavily subsidised to keep the cost as low as possible.

The programme will be as follows and students will sign up to an activity for the whole term (5 lessons):

Pay via parent pay;

- Option 1 (30 places): Bouldering @ Indirock: £15 per term
- Option 2 (12 places): Golf @ Garon's Park Driving Range: £20 per term

If either of these options are not suited for your daughter she will remain on site and engage in a variety of on-site activities including badminton, volleyball and fitness.

All equipment will be provided for the 3 options and students just need to wear their PE kit as normal. Transport will be provided for the offsite activities.

For both offsite activities places are limited, therefore student sign up will be done via payment on parent pay. By paying on parent pay we will take this as permission to take your daughter off-site for this activity. If you sign up your daughter to Indirock there will be a mandatory waiver to complete. This will be sent to you following confirmation of payment.

Please note that any offsite activity is subject to our school behaviour policy and no refunds will be given should your daughter not adhere to these standards.

If your daughter would like to remain on-site during core games for term 2 you do not need to do anything.
