Re: Results' Day- Year 13

A level results' day is **Thursday 15th August 2024** and students can collect results via Go 4 Schools or collect their results from the school canteen **from 8:00 AM.** Students and their family can enter the school through the reception entrance on the corner of Milton and Canewdon Road. Parking for parents will be available on site.

If students are not available on results day, a representative can collect results on their behalf. Students who are not available on results day will need to send an e-mail (from their school email account) to our Examinations Officer, Ms Brown <u>exams@stbernards.southend.sch.uk</u> giving permission for a named representative to collect the results on their behalf. The representative must bring a form of ID which they will need to show on the day to collect the results. We regret that we cannot release results unless we have this confirmation.

Any results not collected by the end of the day on the 15th August will be posted out to the address that we have on file for the student at school. May I ask you to ensure that any changes to address or contact details are notified to the school office before the end of term.

If you are unable to attend and wish to view your results via Go 4 Schools, please ensure that you have checked your access is working. Please could you ensure that you have contacted us if you have any logging on issues **by Monday 8th July 2024.**
